Dear Readers,

While the global economy faced a lot of disruptions on account of the COVID-19 pandemic and geopolitical dislocations in the recent past, the general market sentiment in 2022, however, had been of positivity, especially in India. In 2023, it is hoped that this positive outlook gets converted into actual investments on the ground.

As India remains relatively well-positioned to withstand global headwinds compared to other emerging nations—a fact that's been suitably acknowledged by the World Bank recently—this buoyed market sentiment should provide sufficient fuel for the engines of economic growth to continue running unhindered.

To add to it, India's G20 presidency is a matter of great pride for everyone. This will allow us to showcase our country to the world in a new light.

With India expecting growth of close to 7% in the financial year 2023 and as infrastructure continues to be an area of core focus for the government, these factors are bound to have a spillover effect in terms of the rise of other sectors as well, including real estate.

Despite the gradual surge in property prices and home loan interest rates in 2022, it has been a relatively optimistic year for residential real estate. A recent report by an international property consultant indicates that housing sales in the top seven cities, that is, the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR), the National Capital Region (NCR), Pune, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Kolkata, and Chennai, have created a new peak in 2022, breaching the previous high of 2014. Across the top seven cities, approximately 3,64,900 units were sold in 2022, compared to 2,36,500 units in 2021—a 54% increase year on year (YoY). The last peak was in 2014, when 3.43 lakh units were sold across the top seven cities.

A generic trend that is being observed is that property purchase, which was a sign of wealth quotient before the Covid-19 pandemic, has turned into a necessity now across all age groups. Millennials, who favoured rentals as an option, have realised the importance of owning a home due to higher affordability on account of the reduced gap between loans to rent. Also, people see the true value of staying in gated communities. The preference for larger homes has witnessed a surge, too.

I am pleased to share that our company registered several important accomplishments. Shapoorji Pallonji Real Estate, in its recent collaboration with HDFC Capital Advisors, the success of six of our projects. This collaboration will skyrocket the investment in the company to the next level.

INDEPENDENCE DAY


As the entire country celebrated India's 75th Independence Day on the 15th of August 2022, the Joyville community came together to hoist the national flag with patriotic fervour.


Cricket Tournament at Joyville Howrah


